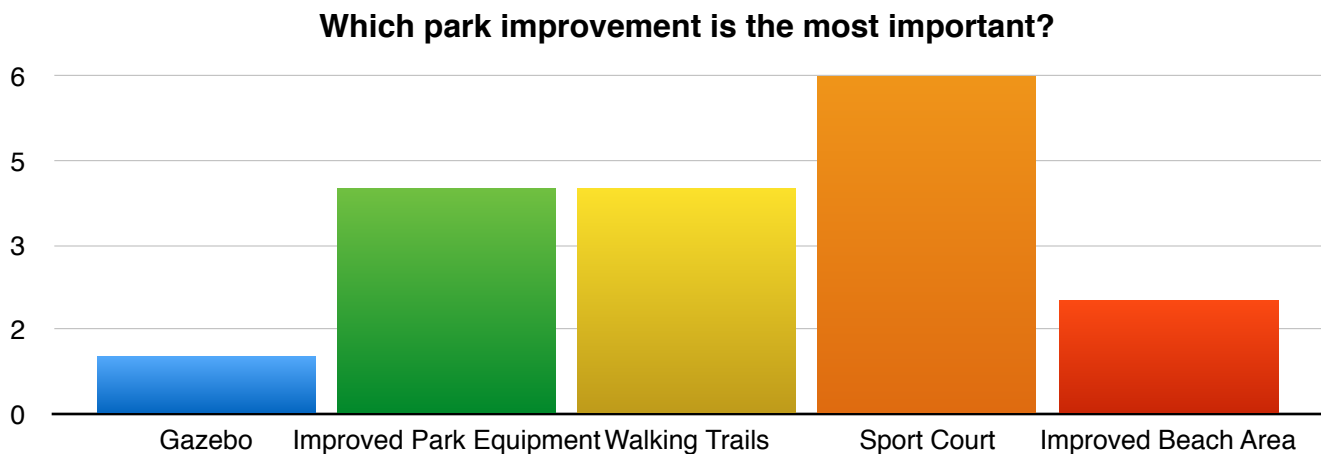


Survey Summary

In early July, we circulated a survey so that we could find out what interests you and what your priorities are for Park Improvements. We received 13 completed surveys with a wide variety of opinions. Here is a summary of the feedback we received.

Respondents unanimously think that we should not pursue a spray park in our Village. Due to the recent opening of a spray park in Dundurn, this would be an unproductive endeavour and will not be pursued.

The Sport Court was the most important park improvement to the largest number of respondents, followed by walking trails and improved park equipment.



For an improved beach area, the following suggestions were received:

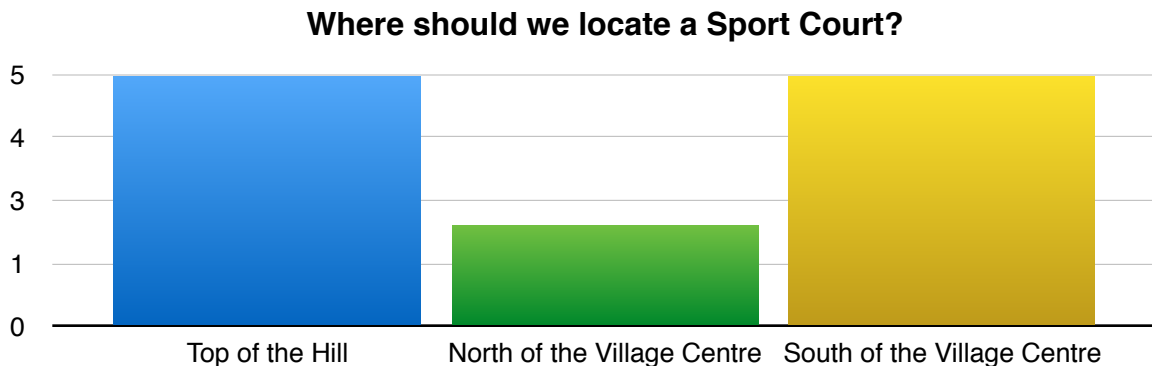
- It would be nice to see beach volleyball poles and net
- Regular cleaning of beach and surrounding area
- Paved parking area
- Graded and more weekly clean up
- No weeds in the water
- More raked sand
- Dock so that residents who boat to the beach area can tie onto.
- Lots of sand
- Weed free area----nicer sand---nicer swimming area

- Docking area or place where boat can be pulled up on the sand, we like to canoe over to the park and feel that we are not supposed to bring our canoe there. Would also be nice to be able to arrive by boat (with motor) and be allowed to pull in there.

Other park improvement suggestions received included:

- A larger community centre
- basketball nets in a location where the ball will not roll into the lake
- skating rink for winter would be great
- areas to sit---more toys for kids----rides for kids—ex--slide
- Park bench where the old one was removed
- Privacy strips on the hill to hide the compound
- Beach volleyball

There was a split in the responses on the preferred location for the Sport Court. The Top of the Hill and the South of the Village Centre got an equal amount of preference.



There is varied interest in the fundraising and social events suggested. The Parks and Recreation Committee will focus on those that were of interest to the most respondents.

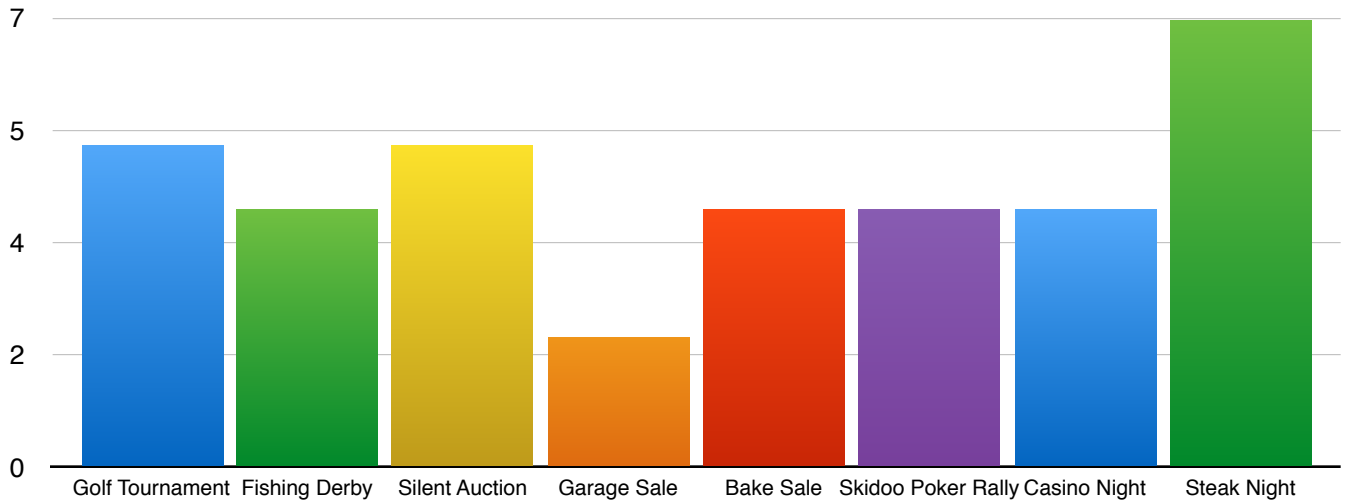
A couple of additional suggestions for events were received:

- Cash cow... Like clothes club. I think it would be excellent especially combined with a potluck. 12 members max

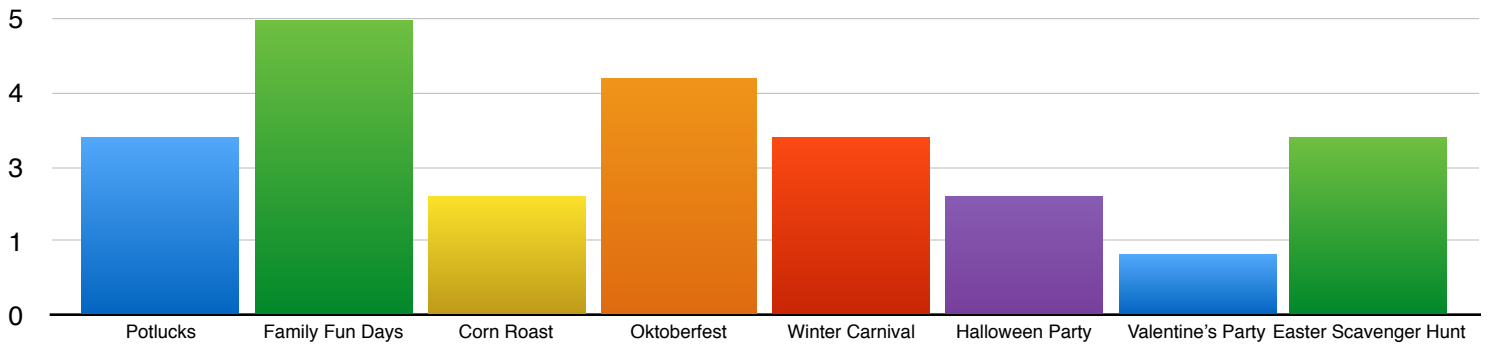
A couple of additional suggestions for classes were received:

Which of these fundraising events interests you?

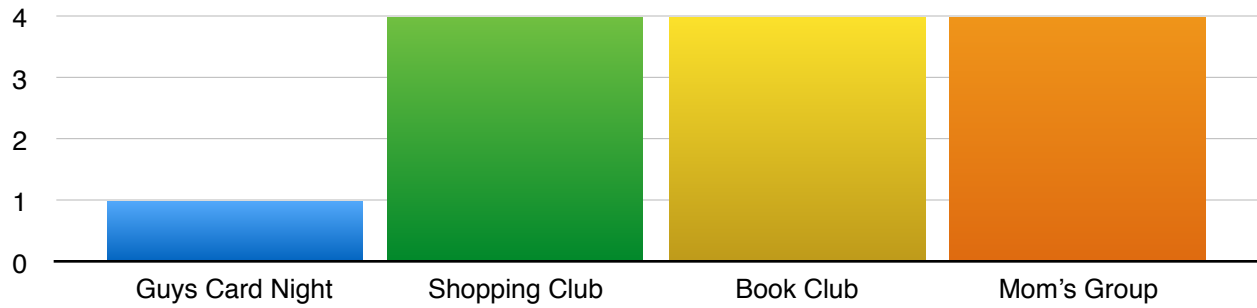


Which of these social events interests you?



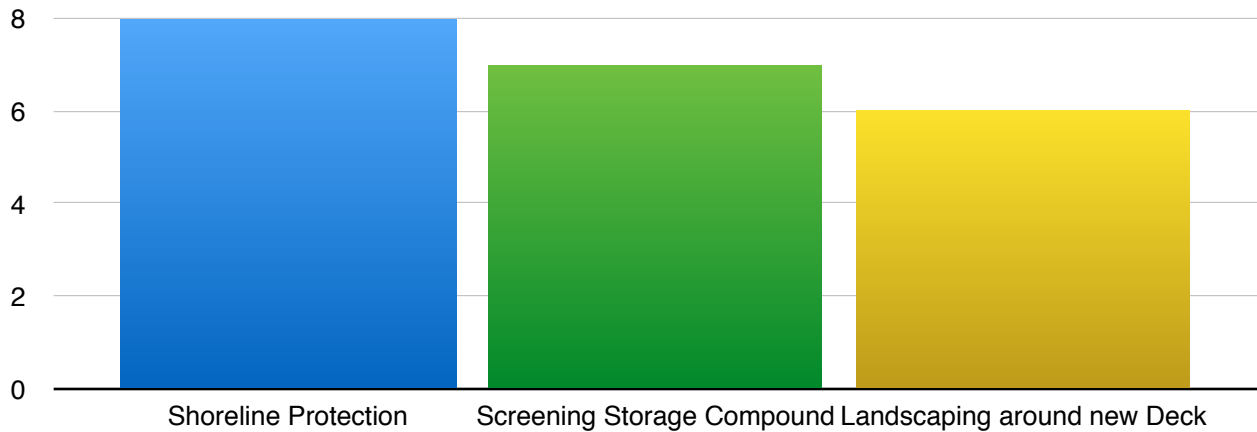
There wasn't a large amount of interest in the monthly clubs. However, it only takes a few interested parties to have a successful group. An additional suggestion for a cycling club was received.

The suggestions included:

- Septic Charges
- Water costs
- Garbage disposal location? Dundurn?
- School Information
- Bus pickup information
- Post Office Box information
- Lake water quality reports
- Landfill hours
- Garbage pickup dates
- Recycling
- Community calendar with important contact numbers and events in community.

- Internet providers
- List of community residents and contact info
- List of events
- List of laws and by-laws pertaining to the community
- List of surrounding attractions e.g. convenience stores, restaurants, golf courses, hotels / motels etc.
- copy of bylaws, expectations, rules, regulations, etc from the village
- phone numbers and addresses of residents
- phone numbers of important contacts in the village
- list of contractors, landscapers, renovators, septic tank businesses, etc., that villagers have used and recommend
- Names of all persons with house numbers in town.
- What trades are available in the community, ex. plumbers, electricians, business owners, etc.
- locally available services and recreation (Dundurn, Hanley, Shields, Det. Dundurn, Thode)
- village directory with names and addresses
- info on village government and committees
- garbage/recycling
- emergency services
